

Recommended Age: 25-30 Months

STEM concepts: Science (physical science), Math (patterns, spatial relationships)

Materials: various puzzles

What to do: Sit with your child in a comfortable level table for your child to reach or the floor. Work with your child to complete puzzles. To not overwhelm them, hand them a couple of pieces at a time that would connect together and let them attempt to complete it themselves.

Language and Communication: Point out to your child why pieces fit differently or better

than others. Show them that colors connect, or shapes of pieces connect together better than others.

Expand the Activity: Try giving them a few pieces that would not connect together and see if they notice or can tell you that they don't go.
