

Recommended Age: 42-47 Months

STEM concepts: Science (physical science), Technology (simple tools), Engineering, Math (shapes and spacial recognition)

Materials: rocks, pebbles, sand, (CAUTION: These materials are choking hazards, do not leave your child unattended) a container, magnifying glass

What to do: Place the sand and the rocks and pebbles into the container. Explore the different colors, shapes and sizes.

Language and Communication:

Discuss the properties of the sand, rocks and pebbles. Talk about sand being tiny tiny little grains of rock. Use the magnifying glass to get a closer look and open up more opportunity to discuss what colors and shapes they may be seeing.

Expand the Activity: Build with the rocks and sand. Can you build a pirate ship? Castle? Car?
